CRITERIA FOR BASIS OF AWARD: The following consideration will be given in the selection of a scholarship recipient:

- 1. Must have an **admission application on file** in the office of Admissions of the college of their choice by **March 1**.
- 2. He/She **must be 4-H Member in Gallia County for at least four years (including the last two years)**.
- 3. He/she must have a **2.5 CGPA or higher in high school**.
- 4. Applicants must submit the following with this application
 - A) **Current High School transcript including A.C.T. or S.A.T. scores,**
 - B) **The AP Compliance form attached to scholarship packet**
 - C) **Typed and fully Completed 4-H Scholarship Application**
- 5. **The application must be typewritten using 11 point font.** You must maintain 1/2 inch left and right margins using the formatted application. Sections and pages can not be added.
- 6. Applicants must submit the following single sided, typed application, may be in a pocket folder or paper clipped together, please DO NOT hole punch.

STIPULATION FOR RETAINING SCHOLARSHIP

In order to retain the scholarship, a recipient must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 at the end of the first year and a 2.75 CGPA at the end of the second year and for all succeeding years. If he/she does not maintain the required GPA at the end of the year, the scholarship will be withdrawn, until higher GPA is achieved. If he/she is not enrolled in college for any reason the scholarship will be stopped or paused until enrollment is achieved.

SELECTION PROCEDURES AND CRITERIA:

- 4-H Experiences-----55%
 - Non-4-H experiences, church & community-----15%
 - Academic accomplishments and potential for success-----30%
- The final decision will also consider financial need.
