I Observe...

Stigma

Sticky surface at the pistil's top, where the pollen germinates

Style

Holds up the stigma

Ovary

Contains the ovules

Ovules

Become the seed after fertilization by pollen

Pistil

The pistil has three parts

Anthers

Pollen producing part

Filament

They hold up the anthers

Stamen

The stamen has two parts

Petals

Usually bright, to attract pollinators such as bees

Sepals

Protect the flower bud when it is developing
