Rules & Regulations:

1. All contestants must be enrolled in a beef, sheep, swine, horse, goat, or dairy project through 4-H or FFA for the current Gallia County Junior Fair.
2. Queen contestants must be at least 15 years of age and not over 19 years of age as date of application.
3. Senior Princess contestants must be at least 12 years of age and not over 14 years of age as date of application.
4. Junior Princess contestants must be at least 9 years of age or in the third grade and not over 11 years of age as of date of application.
5. The same girl cannot hold the title for two consecutive years.
6. All contestants must be residents of Gallia County and be active members of a Gallia County 4-H Club or FFA Chapter.
7. All contestants must submit a wallet-sized photo with this form.
