Now ACCEPTING CAMP COUNSELOR APPLICATIONS!

Teens 14 to 18 by January 1, 2020 can apply to be a summer camp counselor! All residential counselors must complete 20 (for returning) - 25 (for new) training hours to meet the *American Camping Association & Ohio 4-H counselor requirements*. *Camp Counselor Applications are included in this mailing or can be found on the Gallia County Extension website at www.gallia.osu.edu*

- All Counselors **MUST** attend **Counselor College April 4-5 held at Canter's Cave 4-H camp** (*separate forms and counselor fees apply*)
- All **new** counselors will be required to interview with Tracy Winters before being accepted into the program. Individual interviews will be set up on February 17, 2020.
- All applicants will be required to attend the Counselor College training where you will get up to 15 training hours completed.

CARTEENS 2020

As a CARTEEN facilitator, teens can earn leadership hours, community service hours and build teaching skills! The CARTEEN program meets **five times per year** and presents a 90-minute hands on interactive driver's safety program to teens with their first traffic violation. Being a CARTEENS facilitator looks great on scholarship applications, college applications and job resumes! Past presenters have won local and state 4-H scholarships as well as local teen leadership awards. Our local CARTEEN program also offers a \$500 scholarship to selected graduating senior CARTEEN facilitators each year. To be eligible for the CARTEEN scholarship you must serve as an **ACTIVE** member of CARTEENS for at least **two years** including **your senior year**. Participants also learn about the ecology of the lake, have an opportunity to snorkel, go deep sea fishing, and visit stone lab! 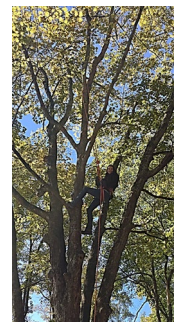
Other Achievement form opportunities for pre-teens!

Ohio 4-H State Scholarships

Ohio 4-H recognizes and rewards individual excellence, whether it is in project work, leadership, citizenship or community service. State and county 4-H scholarship applications are available to graduating 4-H Seniors! To complete the on-line state scholarship form you will need the following information when you log on: High school Grade Point Average (GPA) and rank. Academic honors you have received.

- If you are or will be an Ohio State student, your OSU username.# and ID# (*can be found on your receipt of admission application email*).

- Information about your current or anticipated college or university (name, city, state)
- Intended academic major
- Detailed information about your major 4-H leadership roles; you should know the names of the roles, the years, level(s), duties and accomplishments.
- Detailed information about major 4-H honors that you have received.
- Information about your educational, career, or personal goals and what impact 4-H has had on those ambitions.
- Personal statement explaining why a 4-H scholarship would be important to your achieving a college education AND how 4-H has contributed to your personal development, leadership and other skills and to your likely success in life.

Gallia County 4-H Scholarships

Gallia County currently offers the following scholarships: *The Vic and Mary Walker Niday Scholarship (pending), The Ohio Valley Bank Scholarship, The Gallia County Ag. Center Scholarships, The Gallia County Ag. Society Scholarship, The Wiseman Roach, Waugh Family Scholarships, The Eastman Family Scholarship, The Lynn Angel Scholarship, the 4-H Advisors Scholarship, The Gallia County CARTEEN scholarship, and the Gallia County Horse Committee Scholarship.* These scholarships are open to any **Gallia** County 4-H member who is a senior and who has been active in 4-H for **at least 4 years, including the last two years**. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$4,000. The deadline for these county scholarships is **March 2nd at 4:30PM**. No late forms will be accepted.
